4/05 TUESDAY

Morning - Spend Time at the Hotel Beach and Pools

12:00 PM - Lunch at the Hotel and check-out. Leave luggage in their check-out away.

Early afternoon - Catch bus to Arizona Memorial at Pearl Harbor.

OHAU

3:00 PM - If time available, visit Bowfin/Pacific Submarine Mueum at Pearl Harbor.

5:00 PM - Catch Plane to KAUAI

HAWAH TRIP

KAUAI

Dates: Evening April 5, April 6 (Wednesday) and April 7 (Thursday)

General: Island with the most spectacular landscape. A tiny Island, it has desert in the South East and Tropical Rain Forest in the North. It is probably the best candidate to see by helicopter.

Major Attractions:

- Waimea Grand Canvon
- Na Pali Shore Line

Hotel: Hyatt Regency at Poipu Beach

Airport: Lihue about 14 miles from the Hotel

Schedule:

4/05 TUESDAY

7: 00 PM - Check Into Hotel and Eat Dinner there.

4/06 WEDNESDAY

- 6:00 AM Leave Hotel and Drive to KALAHUA LOOKOUT. It is important to arrive before 10:00AM because clouds form in the valley and obscur the view. The drive is along the Canyon Wall and takes approximately 2 Hours from Hotel.
 - Supposedly this is the most Spectacular view in Hawaii. One can see 4000 ft clifts down the Canyon to Alaki Swamp, Mt. Waialeale, other Islands, etc.
 - Eat Breakfast Picnic of Hawaiian Fruits and the Picnic Ground at the Lookout.
- 10:00 AM Drive back down the Canyon to Kekaha and then to POLIHALE STATE PARK. Visit remains of Temple Polihale Heiall. This is the end of the beach at the edge of the Na Pali coast. View Private island Niihau. Expect to arrive around 11:00.
 - This spot is the end of the road on the south side of the Island. It is the starting point to begin the tour of the attractions on this side of the island.

KAUAI

- 12:00 AM Drive back to Waimea. Stop momentarily along the way to visit the following:
 - BARKING SANDS BEACH: Sand is supposed to make woofing sound as you walk. Only other places this sand is found Egypt, Mongolia, and Saudi Arabia.
 - MENEHUNE DITCH: Supposedly built by Mythical Hobits that work only at night.
 - A Swinging Footbridge over the Waimea River. We walk across the bridge.
 - FORT ELIZABETH STATE PARK: Russian fort is just a pile of rubble at mouth of river.
- 1:00 PM Drive to Hanapepe to view vintage village with wooden sidewalks and weather beaten store fronts.
- 2:00 PM Visit NATIONAL TROPICAL BOTANICAL GARDEN near Koala. There is a 3 hour tour of 186-acre research park with 7000 varieties of plant. (requires advanced reservations)
- 5:00 PM Return to Hotel and Poipu Beach. Walk along the beach and visit the SPOUTING HORN.
- 7:00 PM Dinner at the POIPU BEACH CAFE. It is moderately priced with Itailian-styled foods. It is also a popular nightclub for the evening.

4/07 THURSDAY

- 6:00 AM Drive directly to HAENA STATE PARK. Arrive at 8:30. Park and walk to KE'E BEACH (site of Thornbird's Movie). This is the end of the road along the North side of the Island and the starting point for touring this side of the Island. Bring along Breakfast to eat in the car while driving.
 - Hike the KALALAU TRAIL. This is a trenuous 2-mile long trail into Hanakapiai Valley. It provides a good feel of the spectacular Na Pali coast line. Hike to the Hanakapiai Falls. Supposedly this trail is beyond compare on the rest of the Islands. Unfortuneately we only have time for a short stretch of it.
 - This is the WET side of the Island. Dress for rain and bring a change of clothes. Hopefully, by hitting this spot early we will miss the afternoon rain.
- 1:00 PM Return to KE'E Beach and walk along the beach, visiting MANINIHOLO Dry Cave and TUNNELS Beach.
- 2:00 PM Drive to Hanalei, stopping to view LUMAHAI Beach (site of South Pacific Movie).

 Stop at Hanalei Snack Shop. Visit town of Ramshackle buildings, dramatic mountain views and curving beaches.



- 2:30 PM Drive to KILAUEA NATIONAL WILDLIFE REFUGE and visit the KILAUEA LIGHTHOUSE. This is the World's largest Clamshell Lighthouse. The refuge is home for Monk Seals, green turtles, and occasional whales and dolphins. The exotice birds swarm like bee's. It also provides a good view of Na Pali coast.
- 4:00 PM Drive to HOLO-HOLO-KU HEIAU Temples and visit. This is one of the oldest temples on the Island. Human sacrifice was performed here. On a hill nearby is a small interesting Japanese Cemetery.
- 5:00 PM Drive to COCO PALMS RESORT and watch the famous TORCHLIGHT CEREMONY (at sundown). South Pacific, Blue Hawaii, and Sadie Thompson were filmed here. Some movie props still remain. This is also one of Hawaii's Largest Coconut Groves.
- 7:00 PM Drive to ALOHA DINER in Waipouli for real Hawaiian food (kaula pig, lomi salmon, and poi). It is a small place with few tables, but they prepare heaping dishes of Hawaiian food at budget prices.

4/08 FRIDAY

8:00 AM - Fly to HAWAII

HAWAII

Dates: April 8 (Friday), April 9 (Saturday), and April 10 (Sunday)

General: The largest of the Islands. It has two large 13,000 ft volcanos that block the western shore from winds, making this shore ideal for skin and scuba diving. This island has the most active volcanoes.

Major Attractions:

- Volcanoes National Park
- Skin-diving
- Onizuka International Astronomical Observatory

Hotel: King Kamehamaha, Kona

Airport: KE-Ahole about 2 miles from the Hotel

Schedule:

4/08 FRIDAY

- 10:00 AM Check-in at Hotel. It is assumed that we take a 8AM (approx) flight from KAUAI.
- 12:00 PM Go to ATLANTIS SUBMARINE near Kailua Wharf. It holds 46 passengers and dives to 150ft to explore tropical reefs and sponge gardens.
- 2:00 PM Get bathing suits (although they are not needed) and go to HONOKOHAU BEACH It is Kailua's Nude Beach. It is highly recommended for the adventurous (and midaged voyeurs).
- 5:00 PM Get an Adult beverage (to restart hearts after beach) and go to KAILUA WHARF next to Hotel to watch the famous Hawaiian sunset.
- 7:00 PM Attend THE LUAU at King Kamehamaha.

4/09 SATURDAY

6:00 AM - (or earlier). We have to drive to the other side of the Island and we are going to take Saddle Rd which rises to 6500 ft between Mauna Kea and Mauna Loa. There is nothing for 87 miles on this road, except view, so bring a Box Breakfast. We go past the exit to Onizuka International Center (at 13,000ft), but I haven't figured how to fit it into the trip.

HAWAII

- 8:30 PM Arrive at HILO. It is the closest village in all of Hawaii to a Somerset Maugham style South Sea port town. Visit the ORCHIDS OF HAWAII on a of the highly recommended flower nurseries.
- 9:30 PM Got to AKALA FALLS about 10 miles north of Hilo.
- 11:00 PM Head for VOLCANO NATIONAL PARK.
- 12:00 PM Arrive at KILALEA VISITOR CENTER and examine the museum and watch movies about the area before venturing out on our own.
- 1:00 PM Go to THURSTON LAVA TUBE. Take a hike thru the tube. Then hike DEVASTATION TRAIL, 1/2-mile board walk. Then hike to HALEMAUMAN CRATER. It is still belching steam and sulfurous gas into the air.
- 2:30 PM Leave for JAGGAR MUSEUM. On the way we pass KAU DESERT. The Astronauts trained here for their lunar landing.
- 3:30 PM Head for TREE MOLDS and the PUAULU BIRD PARK (a special stop for Sharyn)
- 5:00 PM Head back toward our Hotel along the southern coast of Hawaii. There is virtually nothing along this route, except Lava Flows, Sugar Cane Groves, and Macadamian Nut farms.
- 7:00 PM Stop a TESHIMA Hotel in Honalo for diner. It is decorated with lanterns and Oriental Painting and serves Japanese delicacies.

4/10 SUNDAY

- 9:00 AM to 12:00 PM Church and Breakfast some place in KAILUA. There is ST. PETER'S CATHOLIC CHURCH on the shore of KAHALUU BAY, but it is precariously perched on a lava foundation and is reputed to be the world's second-smallest church.
- 1:00 PM Go Skin-Diving at OLD AIRPORT BEACH. We can rent or buy diving equipment in town. It is just north of town. It is the best beach in the area for skin-diving and the waters are spectacular (according to my book). Many glass bottom boats tour this area.

Alternate Plan (In Case you don't want to Skin-Dive)

1:00 PM - Take a Tour of the North West Side (KOHALA) of the Island via WAIMEA, KOHALA, MAHUKONA, KAWAIHAI and KIHOLO BAY.

HAWAII

5:00 PM - Return to the Hotel.

7:00 PM - Dinner at STAN'S RESTAURANT. It is moderately priced and has atmosphere. Not easy to find in a very expense area.

4/11 MONDAY

8:00 AM - Fly to MAUI

MAUI

Dates: April 11 (Monday) thru April 15 (Friday), April 16 Head for Home.

General: Aside from Haleakala Crater, there are no Major Attractions on this Island. It has, however, a combination of all the prominent features of the other Islands. If one can visit only one Island, Maui is probably the best choice.

- Haleakala Crater

Hotel: Embassy Suites Resort, Kaanapali (Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday)

4/13 WEDNESDAY

- 8:00 AM Prepare a "Box Dinner" to eat while viewing the Sunset and the stars. Need a few bottles of wine, cheese, etc.
- 9:00 AM Head for HALEAKALA CRATER. It takes 2 hours to reach top of crater from Hotel. Spend the Day and Evening at the Crater. WARNING: It will be COLD (30-deg) at the top of the crater. To get a weather report call 572-7749 or 871-5054. Possible ways to experience the crater:
 - Half-Day Horse-back ride on the Crater Trails, via PONY EXPRESS TOURS (667-2202).
 - Take one of the many hiking trails
 - There are also bicycle trips
- 6:35 PM (If the weather permits) View Sunset from the Top of the Crater and Star Gaze at the Observatory.
- 7:30 PM Return to Hotel. I had hoped that we could view stars from observatory, but ride back to hotel is just too long.

4/14 THURSDAY

Sunrise at Crater - Can not do. Could not get KULA LODGE and EMBASSY just too far away.

- 8:00 AM Check-out of the EMBASSY HOTEL.
