IRELAND

From Aug 22 to Sep 1, 2006

- Before we leave purchase <u>Heritage Card</u> (\$16 for Seniors). You have to fill it out on their WEB Site THEN COPY the form to an e-mail addressed to
- August 22 PM, fly out of Nashville/Chicago (12:50P/1:00P) to Shannon, Ireland
- August 23 WED 6:30AM, arrive in Shannon, Rented two Volvo V70, standard transmission from Avis for \$723.37 PRE-PAID (\$391.01 GBP) per car. Communications between cars via VHF radio.
- Drive 40 miles (N24) to Cashel, visit Rock of Cashel & have lunch: Brief History, Tourist pictures
- Drive 40 miles to <u>Launard House</u> a <u>B&B</u> in <u>KilKenny</u> (Stay 4 nights, 23,24,25,26 in Kilkenny COST = \$325 Euros/couple)

- August 24 THU FREE DAY relax and roam Kilkenny

Nothing planned for this day, except recover from the time change. I suggest you <u>print a copy of this map</u> of Kilkenny for your use. Everyone should do what they find convenient. <u>Breadfast is in the B&B</u>. Ride or walk into town, raom, and then have lunch. *Kilkenny* has one Pub for every 300 citizens. We'll ask the B&B owners to point us to something "colorful" for the evening.

- Visit Old Jail House, Black Abbey, St. Francis Abbey, & Kilkenny Castle
- Lunch at Kyteler's Inn, once 1323 home of witch Dame Alice Kyteler

- August 25 FRI 8:30AM go to <u>Dublin</u>

Breakfast in the B&B. At 8:30AM we'll drive to *Dublin* and to the *Guinness Tour* which lasts about an hour, have lunch in a convenient pub and then catch the bus ride around for the 90 minutes discussion of the city highlights and then hop off where-ever.

- In the morning drive 65 miles to *Dublin* and do *Guinness Storehouse Tour*. This tour costs about **\$20pp**. In the *Gravity Bar* we will drink our complimentary pint of Guiness and have lunch.
- In the afternoon roam *Dublin* using *Hop-On-Off Bus Tour*. The ticket costs **\$20pp** and the tour lasts 75 minutes. After that you select a spot to get off and do your own thing.
- Head back to *Kilkenny* around **6:30PM** (we may have to have a lite dinner while driving to avoid driving Ireland roads in the dark.)

- August 26 SAT 9:00 AM go to Waterford and Wexford

<u>Breakfast in the B&B</u>. About mid-morning we'll drive about thirty miles to southeast coast and the **Water-ford Tour** which lasts about an hour, have lunch in a convenient pub and the drive over to Wexford. Dinner near **Irish National Heritage Park**.

- 9A to Noon: Visit Waterford Crystal
- We can visit several place in the afternoon such as <u>Dunbrody Abbey</u>, <u>Jerpoint Abbey</u>, <u>or</u>
 <u>Dunbrody Famine Ship</u>. I suggest we drive to <u>Wexford</u> and visit the <u>Irish National Heritage Park</u>.
- Noon to 4PM: Visit Irish National Heritage Park. It is outdoors & requires walking.
- I suggest we drive into *Wexford* and have an early dinner at *The Sky & Ground Pub* at 112-113 South Main St. It is only an hour drive back to *Kilkenny*.

- August 27 SUN 9:00 AM go to Killarney through Cork,

Breakfast in the B&B and pack your bags. About **9AM** we leave for a long drive to *Killarney* in southwest corner of Ireland. Primary stop is *Blarney Castle* for a leisurely visit. I had thought we could visit *Cobh Heritage Center*, but it is on the other side of *Cork* and trying to fit it into the day is too much.

- 11AM to 2PM: Visit *Blarney Castle*. We are probably going to need a picnic lunch.
- 3PM: Arrive at our B&B <u>Wuthering Heights</u> near <u>Killarney National Park</u> (stay 3 nights, 27,28, 29 in Killarney COST = \$281 Euros/couple) (Warning: I am very nervous about this B&B selection. It was not my first choice and in 2003 it received some bad reviews)
- August 28 MON and 29 TUE are interchangeable depending on the weather. <u>Breakfast in the B&B</u>, then take your pick of the following two day plans.
 - At **9AM** leave for the <u>Ring of Kerry</u> (<u>General Info</u>) Although the <u>Ring of Kerry</u> is only 130 miles in length, it is the 2'nd most popular tourist destination in Ireland. Travel will be slow and traffic will be heavy. We will easily spend 8 hours doing the loop.
 - At whenever AM roam town of Killarney and doing a little <u>sightseeing</u>. At 8PM go to an *Old Irish* Banquet (\$60pp) at <u>Killarney Manor House</u>
- August 30 WED 9AM go Galway

<u>Breakfast in the B&B</u> and pack your bags. About **9AM** we have a long drive along the western coast of Ireland to Galway.

- At 11:30AM visit Cliffs of Moher
- At 1:00PM visit The Burren,
- At 5:00 PM arrive at Mandalay by the Sea a B&B in Galway, (stay 2 nights, 30,31 in Galway COST = \$161/couple)
- August 31 THU FREE DAY relax and roam Galway,

After three days of heavy driving, it is time to relax. <u>Breakfast in the B&B</u> and walk along the coast and into *Galway*. Do what-ever. Dinner that night somewhere in *Galway*. We'll get ideas from the B&B owners.
